Dear Sir,

Hon'ble WBERC has issued Tariff order for WBSEDCL on 04.03.15, and has allowed two-part Tariff for sale of power to CESC Ltd by WBSEDCL under certain conditions i.e. WBSEDCL shall have to execute a fresh Power Sale Agreement, in replacement of existing Agreement executed on 2<sup>nd</sup> December 2010. The gist of Tariff as admitted by WBERC is as hereunder:

We have already forwarded the Draft Power Sale Agreement to CESC Limited under cover of our letter no. C/BC/CEsc/General/527 dated 11 May 2015 originally addressed to CESC with a copy endorsed to Hon'ble WBERC.

CEsc Limited has not yet responded to agree to the Draft Power Sale Agreement which may be submitted to the Commission within three month as per stipulation of clause no. 8.14 of Tariff order dated 04.03.2015 for WBSedCL.

CEsc, upto 03.06.2015 has drawn Power maximum 330MW. CESC submitted a proposal vide their letter dated 29 May 2015 that they will draw 100 MW (reduced from 330MW) RTC power for the period of two month from 04 June'15 as per 2 part tariff; if required additional Power drawal beyond 100MW under exigency for excess energy drawal (corresponding to excess power drawn over 100MW) may be drawn at single part tariff.

We have forwarded the proposal of CESC to the Govt. of West Bengal for a policy decision. MIC, Power & NES has conveyed the approval in this regard vide letter no. 124-PO/O/C-III/3R-05/2014 dated 05 June 2015, enclosed). Now as directed, the matter is being forwarded to Hon'ble WBERC for kind perusal and final decision as far as tariff determination is concerned.



We refer to the discussions held on 20 May 2015 between Chairman & Managing Director, WBSEDCL and Managing Director, CESC on the above subject.


In accordance with the decisions taken therein, CESC confirms its willingness to purchase 100 MW power (reduced from 330 MW) from WBSEDCL for a period of two months from 4 June 2015 at the following terms/ rate(s), computed in line with the order issued by the Hon'ble Commission in Case No. TP-56/13-14 for CESC Limited:

- An Energy Charge of 252 paise/kWh
- A Fixed Charge of Rs.771.21 Lakhs per month (Rs.2545 Lakhs ÷ 330 MW x 100 MW).
- In the event of power drawal beyond 100 MW under exigency, a single-part tariff of Rs.736.68 paise/kWh for the excess energy drawn (corresponding to excess power drawn over 100 MW) will be applicable
- Other conditions would continue to be in terms of the aforesaid Order issued by the Hon'ble Commission.

Dear Sir,

As per existing Agreement executed on 2<sup>nd</sup> December, 2010, the contracted capacity for sale of power to CESC is 705 MVA at five Offtake point s namely Kasba, Liluah, Howrah, Titagarh, Rishra. As per tariff order of WBSEDCL issued by WBERC dtd. 4.3.2015, CESC has been allowed to draw maximum demand to the extent of 330MW. Energy balance of WBSEDCL has been carried out considering sale of power to CESC 630MU for the period 2015-16.

CESC Ltd. has given a month-wise projection for drawal of power during 2015-16 as hereunder.

Accordingly, WBSEDCL has filed its tariff petition considering above projection. Tariff for sale of power to CESC has been determined by WBERC with fixed charge during 2015-16 Rs.25,40Crs. and variable charge as Rs.2.52p. per KWH. CESC Ltd. has been persued several times from this office for execution of an agreement as per directives of WBERC and draft copy of the agreement has been forwarded to them. CESC Ltd. has not yet responded to it. Under this situation, it is totally uncertain whether CESC will execute agreement within the stipulated period

Meanwhile, CESC is claiming for RTC power @ 330MW and during the period April and May, we have already supplied power more than 85 MU per month. CESC have made a discussion with us that they may require 100 MW RTC power during June/July and for the balance period, they have not yet given any indication how much power they may draw. As such, it is very difficult to come to a decision what will be the agreed maximum annual drawal.


Now, under the above circumstances, the Hon<sup>ble</sup> WBERC may please advise on the following matter :

Part tariff

- (i) If CESC do not agree to execute agreement afresh as per direction of the WBERC what will be the date of effect of single as per tariff order dtd.4.3.2015.
- (ii) If CESC draws RTC power less than 330MW for part of the financial year and do not draw any power for balance period of the financial year, then what will be the tariff applicable.

Under such circumstances, how the revenue loss due to less drawal of power by CESC would be taken care. An advice in this regard may be forwarded at the earliest please.

We would like to mention here that WBSEDCL use to purchase Power at existing off-take points (Ex Section 27 Industrial Consumers & WBSEDCL Sub-station). Purchase of Power from CESC is adjusted against Sale of Power to CESC limited and adjustment bill is used to rise by WBSEDCL. Now due to implementation of SAP system, the purchase and sale bill will be treated as separately. There is no provision of adjustment bill considering sale bill and purchase bill to be done separately in the SAP System. Therefore, no adjustment bill will be raise from this end.

It is requested to execute the agreement accordingly for purchase of power by WBSEDCL from CESC Ltd .at already existing off-take points (Ex Section 27 Industrial Consumers & WBSEDCL Sub-station).



We have gone through your reply vide your letter dated 06 May 2015 referred to above. Found the issue concerned to WBSEDCL is not addressed. You are well aware that CESC Ltd. has provided the drawal of energy from WBSEDCL vide their letter no. VP (SO):1248 dated 05 November 2013 (letter enclosed). WBSEDCL accordingly considered the same while filing Multi Year Tariff Petition 2014-17 to Hon'ble WBERC considering the energy drawal mentioned in letter dated 05 November 2013 and the same has been considered by Hon'ble WBERC as sale of energy to CESC Limited as 1810 MU for 2014-15, 630 MU for 2015-16, 685 MU for 2016-17 under ANNEXURE-6I of Tariff order of WBSEDCL for the year 2014-15.

We have forwarded Power Sale Agreement as directed by Hon'ble WBERC in the tariff order for 2014-15. We understand that your advice / directive given in the tariff order is general in nature and while finalizing the drafting revised draft Power Sale Agreement as directed by Hon'ble WBERC in the tariff order we are facing the following difficulties.

1. As the Fixed cost has been computed considering Maximum peak demand of power of 330 MW for FY 2015-16, 385 MW for FY 2016-17. So power of 330 MW for FY 2015-16, 385 MW for



It appears from Annexure-6D that fixed charge for CESC Ltd in the tariff order dated 04 March 2015 of WBSEDCL, is calculated considering the sharing of CESC in MW i.e. 330 MW for FY 2015-16, 385 MW for FY 2016-17 (5.12 % for FY 2015-16, 5.44 % for FY 2016-17) in projected peak system demand of WBSEDCL (6441 MW for FY 2015-16, 7080 MW for FY 2016-17). Thus it appears that RTC power of 330 MW for FY 2015-16, 385 MW for FY 2016-17 can not be scheduled to CESC. On the other hand CESC import from WBSEDCL in MU are 1810 MU for 2014-15, 630 MU for 2015-16, 685 MU for 2016-17 under ANNEXURE-6I of Tariff order of WBSEDCL for the year 2014-15. If on RTC basis 330 MW for FY 2015-16, 385 MW for FY 2016-17 is considered, energy drawal by CESC will be much higher than 630 MU for 2015-16, 685 MU for 2016-17. WBSEDCL shall have the obligation to supply power to CESC in line with their letter dated 05.11.2013, keeping in view of Per unit, average rate of supply of Power, as per tariff order.



a) The Commission in the Tariff Order dated 04.03.2015 in respect of WBSEDCL has approved the purchase price of power of CESC Ltd. from WBSEDCL for the years 2014-15, 2015-16 and 2016-17 under two part tariff mechanism.


b) In the Tariff Order dated 04.03.2015, Commission has also given direction for execution of a Power Purchase Agreement between WBSEDCL and CESC for purchase of power by CESC from WBSEDCL under two part tariff mechanism and to submit a draft agreement as agreed by both WBSEDCL and CESC Ltd. to the Commission within three (3) months from the date of issue of the Tariff Order.



c) While admitting the two part tariff the Commission approved the fixed cost to be recovered by WBSEDCL from CESC during the years 2014-15, 2015-16 and 2016-17 based on the agreed annual maximum drawal of 620 MW, 330 MW and 385 MW respectively for the year 2014-15, 2015-16 and 2016-17 as projected by WBSEDCL in their tariff petition. The admitted fixed charge is subject to condition of change in agreed annual maximum drawal as considered in the order for the respective years.

d) In two part tariff mechanism the Commission has approved the energy charge rate in paise/kWh for the years 2014-15, 2015-16 and 2016-17. CESC Ltd. shall pay energy charge during any year at the rate as approved by the Commission for the respective year on the actual drawal of energy. There is no provision of claiming of additional energy charge by WBSEDCL in case of excess purchase of energy by CESC Ltd. than projected sale of WBSEDCL to CESC Ltd. in their tariff petition. CESC Ltd. shall pay additional demand charge in case of drawal more than agreed annual maximum drawal, if agreed by WBSEDCL as per the formula given in the Tariff Order.



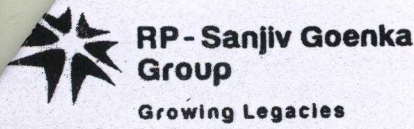

**2.2 Sale to other licensee:**

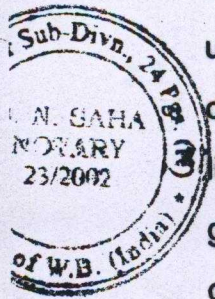
2.2.1. As per projection given by CESC Ltd. vide letter no VP (SO): 1284 dated 05.11.2013 (see Annexure-1A of Appendix A), the supply of power to CESC Ltd has been estimated at 1810 MU, 630 MU and 685 MU during the years FY15, FY16 and FY17 respectively.

In view of wide variation of drawal of power during peak, normal and off-peak period of different seasons with respect to the contract demand of the Agreement, for determination of the monthly fixed charge for supply to CESC by WBSEDCL, the peak power requisition of CESC Limited in month of April, i.e 620 MW, 330 MW, 385 MW for the years FY15, FY16 and FY17 respectively has been considered [Refer Letter dated 28.01.2014 of CESC Ltd. (see Annexure-1B of Appendix A)] as from past experience it has been observed that WBSEDCL usually faces the highest demand of its system of the year during evening peak of April month for meeting its own consumer demand and the demand of the licensees of the state during that period. Based on such peak demand, generation capacity is blocked through long-term PPA. Based on the ratio of demand of CESC from WBSEDCL and total demand arises out in WBSEDCL system during April of the year, the capacity charge against CESC's drawal has been computed. Hence Monthly fixed charge has been projected as Rs 4764 Lakh, Rs 2819 Lakh and Rs 3261 Lakh corresponding to the above stated peak demand of CESC during the month of April for the years FY15, FY16 and FY17 for sharing the capacity charge of WBSEDCL for the above quantum of power. For drawal of more power than the above stated demand taken into consideration in any month, fixed charge for that month will be proportionately increased.

The energy charge during peak, normal and off-peak period of different seasons for the power supply to CESC Ltd has been considered for the years FY15, FY16 and FY17 as follows where peak power rate and off-peak power rate of

CESC has also given their acceptance to the introduction of two part tariff for supply of power to CESC by WBSEDCL in response to discussion and letter dated 10.02.2014 of WBSEDCL [Refer Letter dated 19.02.2014 of CESC Ltd. (see Annexure-2 of Appendix A)].

2.2.2. DPL draws power occasionally from WBSEDCL at the time of its low generation availability, if surplus power is available with WBSEDCL. As per drawal trend of DPL, the drawal of power by DPL has been estimated at 200 MU every year during the years FY15, FY16 and FY17.

In view of the above stated infirm nature of power drawal by DPL, WBSEDCL has not considered any monthly fixed charge for sale of power to DPL for the years FY15, FY16 and FY17. However WBSEDCL has considered the energy charge rate during peak, normal and off-peak period of different seasons for the power supply to DPL for the years FY15, FY16 and FY17 as follows where peak power rate and off-peak power rate of any season has been considered at 110% and 90% of normal period rate of the same season respectively:

- c) Third mechanism to handle incidental surplus power is to inject such surplus power into the grid through Un-scheduled Interchange (UI) mechanism within permissible limit. As this injection can not be projected due to the fact that it occurs on real time operation only. Thus at present injection through UI is not being considered though it will be considered in the APR.

This has reference to your communication bearing Memo No.C/BP/CESC/General/206 dated 04 March 2015, which was received in our office only on 10<sup>th</sup> March 2015.

As already submitted to you during our meeting on 10<sup>th</sup> March 2015, Hon'ble West Bengal Electricity Regulatory Commission has issued tariff order for the Distribution Licensees including CESC covering the period 2014-15, 2015-16 and 2016-17. The said order lays down principles, methodologies and a defined timeframe for actions to be taken by parties in respect of power supply by WBSEDCL to CESC, its tariff and other related issues. Accordingly, we request that your views on the action plan may be communicated to us immediately; we are required to follow the tariff order and the timeline prescribed therein. If required, a meeting may be convened by you in the matter.

The new Tariff Order has introduced 2-part tariff system for the energy purchased by CESC from WBSEDCL with effect from 01<sup>st</sup> March 2015, consisting of a Monthly Fixed Charge and Energy Charge. The Annual Maximum Drawal from WBSEDCL for 2014-15 (i.e. applicable for March 2015) has been considered as 620 MW by CESC in line with submissions of WBSEDCL. The corresponding figures for


2015-16 & 2016-17 have been considered as 330 MW & 385 MW respectively. In the event, such figures on maximum drawal are increased or decreased for any of the years, as per terms and conditions of proposed PPA to be entered into as per the timeline prescribed, the monthly fixed charge for that year is to be accordingly increased or decreased proportionately. By the said order, Monthly fixed charge for the corresponding years have been fixed at Rs 4314 Lakh, Rs 2545 Lakh & Rs 2885 Lakh per month and energy charge at 260.00 Paise, 252.00 Paise & 252.00 Paise per kwh respectively, purchased at CESC Interconnection Point.

In the said order, the Hon'ble Commission also has advised that "CESC Ltd. is to consider for arranging of purchase of power from different source(s) (including from exchanges) other than the existing sources having supply pattern and cost involvement/economics more favourable for consumers of CESC Ltd.". Accordingly, the same is being worked out at our end.

Needless to mention that CESC would continue to dispatch power purchased from WBESDCL in accordance with provisions of law including tariff orders issued by the Hon'ble West Bengal Electricity Regulatory Commission, duly keeping in mind the interest of its consumers, as always.



WBERC in its Tariff order for sale of power to CESC have indicated that Annual Maximum Drawal by CESC for 2015-16 is 330 MW and accordingly 330MW shall be made available as discussed for the ensuing period of 2015-16.






Thank you for your letter no. PTR/CESC/2/314 dated 30<sup>th</sup> March 2015.



We would like to invite your attention to our letter dated 16 January 2015 referred to above through which we intimated you about the scenario for making available and keeping available the declared supply on RTC basis as per Power Sale Agreement and requested you to adhere to the declared Capacity instead of as and when required basis. But it is observed that CESC still not adhere to the declared Capacity and drawing power on as and when required basis.


To- make such arrangement of power, WBSEDCL well in advance have taken necessary measure through signing agreement with Generating utilities on Long Term basis under two part tariff. As such we have to bear Capacity Charge for the Contracted Capacity taking into consideration of our obligation to supply Power to CESC as per Declared Capacity in the Power Sale Agreement.

But it is our experience that you are not sticking to you declared supply as per agreement. Moreover it is observed during past 3 years that whatever you have declared to draw Power (particularly in March & April) from WBSEDCL, you have not drawn, the same when WBSEDCL arranged to procure power at higher cost considering your requirement. And WBSEDCL had to dispose the surplus quantum at lower price & incurred loss. Thus the Contracted power arranged for you incurred additional cost to us.

To short out the issue a meeting between CESC Ltd & WBSEDCL is convened on 24<sup>th</sup> January 2015 at 11.00 Hrs in PTR Conference Room, Bidyut Bhavan.

It is requested to present in the meeting and finalise the above issue.
