
Sir,

As per your afresh directives communicated to this end vide your letter dated 11.08.15 . referred to above , WBSEDCL has raised the bill at single part tariff in line with order dated 04.03.15 read with paragraph 6.5.3 and the directive given in paragraph 8.14.

Accordingly bills for consumption month of April'15, May'15 , June'15 & July'15 for sale of power by WBSEDCL to CESC Ltd have been regenerated under single part Tariff @ Rs 7.3667/Kwh. An additional amount of Rs 82.43 Crores becomes receivable to WBSEDCL over and above the amounts already paid by CESC Ltd due to such regeneration . Due Date of the claim of Rs 82.43 Crores was 31.08.2015 but CESC Ltd, vide their letter dated 29.08.15 has refused to pay the claim and requested for withdrawal of the claim for the amount of Rs 82.43Crores.

Dear Sir,

We beg for decision in regard to tariff for drawal of power by CESC from WBSEDCL in the changed scenario. The changed scenario of power drawal by CESC has already been informed by WBSEDCL vide letter dated 08 June 2015 & 27/29 July 2015 referred to above through which we communicated that CESC has submitted a proposal that they will draw 100 MW (reduced from 330MW) RTC power for two month from 04 June'15 as per two part tariff, if required additional Power drawal beyond 100MW under exigency for excess energy drawal (corresponding to excess power drawn over 100MW) may be drawn at single part tariff.

Department of Power & NES Govt. of West Bengal has conveyed the approval on proposal of CESC in this regard vide letter no. 124-PO/O/C-III/3R-05/2014 dated 05 June 2015. As directed by Govt, the matter was forwarded to Hon'ble WBERC for kind perusal and final decision as far as tariff determination is concerned. Now our submission for decision in regard to tariff for drawal of power by CESC from WBSEDCL in the changed scenario, may please be issued.

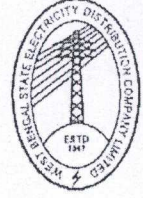

Regenerated bills i.r.o CESC Ltd. for sale of power by West Bengal State Electricity Distribution Company Limited ("WBSEDCL") for the consumption months of April 2015, May 2015, June 2015 & July 2015

We write with reference to your letter no. C/CESC/Regeneration/1002 dated 21.08.2015 whereby the "regenerated" energy bills have been issued to be paid by CESC Limited for the months of April 2015, May 2015, June 2015 and July 2015 under the Single Part Tariff System @ Rs. 7.3667 per kWh purportedly showing an additional amount of Rs. 82.43 crores (approximately) after adjustments, over and above the amounts already paid by us, for the consumption during the aforesaid months.

For ready reference, we give a summary of the bills already raised by you and settled by us i.r.o the subject period.

In this context, we would like to draw your kind attention to the meeting between Chairman & Managing Director, WBSEDCL and Managing Director, CESC Limited held on 20 May 2015, wherein the following decisions were arrived at regarding the mode of operation after completion of the stipulated period of three months from the date of issuance of the MYT Order:-

1. CESC would purchase 100 MW power (reduced from 330 MW) from WBSEDCL for a period of two months from 4 June 2015.
2. Rate of Energy Charge – 252 paise per kWh.
3. Fixed charge - Rs. 771.21 lakhs per month (proportional to the reduced drawal of 100 MW).
4. In the event of drawal beyond 100 MW under exigency, a single part tariff of 736.68 paise per kWh for the excess energy drawn (corresponding to excess power drawn over 100 MW) will be applicable.
5. Other conditions would continue to be in terms of the Order issued by the Hon'ble Commission in Case No. TP-56/13-14 dated 04.03.2015 for CESC Limited.

Following that meeting, CESC Limited had submitted letter no. ED(CS&SO):0263 dated 29.05.2015 to WBSEDCL recording the above-said offer with the applicable terms & conditions.

Further, in this context, we request you to refer to Paragraph 2.2 of the Tariff Order dated 10.08.2015 ("**Tariff Order**") issued by the Hon'ble Commission, for CESC Limited for 2015-16 which duly acknowledged the outcome of the aforesaid meeting and consequent revision in Supply/Purchase Plan and stated as under:-

"It appears the Department of Power & NES, Govt. of West Bengal has approved this power purchase plan vide their letter no. 124-PO/0/C-111/3R-05/2014 dated 05.06.2015."

We would also like to refer to Paragraph 2.4 of the same Tariff Order where the Hon'ble Commission has also decided to revise the power purchase cost of CESC Limited as per such revised plan, providing, *inter alia*, details of month wise Agreed Annual Maximum Demand, corresponding Fixed and Energy Charges.

As stated hereinabove, for the months of April 2015 to July 2015, CESC Limited had duly paid for the power purchased from WBSEDCL in terms of the bills raised by it for quanta of power at payable rates in a manner as per directions given in the MYT Order and the terms and conditions of CESC's letter no. ED (CS&SO):0263 dated 29.05.2015.


Under the circumstances, we are constrained to note that your letter no. C/CESC/Regeneration/1002 dated 21 August 2015 containing the "re-generated energy bills for the power purchased by CESC Limited for the months of April 2015 to July 2015" goes against the spirit of the discussion of fixing the terms/conditions of the power purchase plan, approval of GOWB for the same as well as the MYT Order and the Tariff Order of CESC Limited for the relevant year(s) issued by the Hon'ble Commission and therefore, we regret our inability to consider the same for payment by CESC Limited.

In view of the above, we would request you to kindly take immediate necessary action for withdrawing the referred bill.
