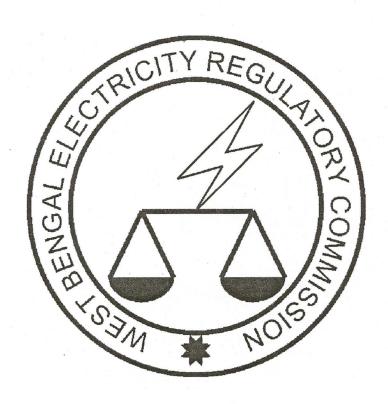

Separate Audit Report on the Accounts of West Bengal Electricity Regulatory Commission for the year ended 31st March 2013.

We have audited the attached Balance Sheet of West Bengal Electricity Regulatory Commission for the year ended 31 March 2013 and the Income and Expenditure Account for the year ended on that date under Section 104 of the Electricity Act, 2003. The audit of accounts of the Commission has been undertaken by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under Section 19 (2) of the Comptroller and Auditor General's Duties, Powers and Conditions of Service (DPC) Act, 1971 read with Section 104 (2) of the Electricity Act, 2003. These financial statements are the responsibility of the Commission's management. Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on our audit.

This separate Audit Report contains the comments of the Comptroller & Auditor General of India (CAG) on the accounting treatment only with regard to classification, conformity with best accounting practices, accounting standards, disclosure norms, etc. Audit observations on financial transactions with regards to compliance with the Law, Rules and regulations (Propriety and Regularity) and efficiency-cum-performance aspects etc, if any, are reported through Inspection Reports/CAG's Audit Reports separately.

We have conducted our audit in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in India. These standards require that we plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements are free from material misstatements. An audit includes examining, on a test basis, evidence supporting the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements. An audit also includes assessing the accounting principles used and significant estimates made by management, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of financial statements. We believe that our audit provides a reasonable basis for our opinion.

Based on our audit, we report that:

- i. We have obtained all the information and explanations, which to the best of our knowledge and belief were necessary for the purposes of our audit;
- ii. The Balance Sheet and Income and Expenditure Account dealt with by this report have been drawn up in the format approved by the Government of West Bengal under Section 104(1) read with Section 180(2) of the Electricity Act, 2003.
- iii. In our opinion, proper books of accounts and other relevant records have been maintained by the Commission as required under Section 104(1) of the Electricity Act, 2003 read with the Rule 5 of the West Bengal Electricity Regulatory Commission (annual statement of accounts) Rules, 2004 in so far as it appears from our examination of such books.

iv. We further report that:

A. Income and Expenditure Account

Commission/Fees - Rs. 531.13 lakh

The above does not include Rs. 219.10 lakh towards fees for Multi Year Tariff from the Generating Companies/Licensees for the year 2012-13. Since the Commission had received an amount of Rs. 657.29 lakh towards multi year tariff fee for the period from 2011-12 to 2013-14 the same should have been accounted on proportionate basis. The Commission had wrongly booked Rs. 580.09 lakh and Rs. 77.20 lakh as income for the year 2011-12 & 2012-2013 respectively instead of accounting on proportionate basis for the current year and the balance as income as pre-revised fees.

This has resulted in understatement of prior period adjustment by Rs. 361.00 lakh and understatement of Commission/Fees by Rs. 141.90 lakh with consequent understatement of excess of income over expenditure for the current year in the Income and Expenditure Account by Rs. 141.90 lakh. This has also resulted in overstatement of 'Capital fund' and understatement of 'Sundry creditors & Other Liabilities' in Balance Sheet by Rs. 219.10 lakh each.

B. Significant Accounting Policies/Notes to Accounts (Schedule-F)

A reference is invited to item No. 3 of the Significant accounting policies/Notes to accounts wherein it was stated that Depreciation on Fixed Assets has neither been quantified nor provided for by the Commission. This is violation of Accounting Standard (AS-6 Depreciation Accounting) issued by the Council of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India.

- v. Subject to our observations in the preceding paragraphs, we report that the Balance Sheet and Income and Expenditure Account dealt with by this report are in agreement with the books of accounts.
- vi. In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us, the said financial statements subject to the significant matters stated above give a true and fair view in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in India:
 - (a) In so far as it relates to the Balance Sheet, of the state of affairs of the Commission as at 31 March 2013; and
 - (b) In so far as it relates to the Income and Expenditure Account, of the excess of income over expenditure for the year ended on that date.

The other aspect and working results of the Commission for the last three years are given in Annexure - I & II.

REPLIES TO COMMENTS ON THE SEPARATE AUDIT REPORT ON THE ACCOUNTS OF WEST BENGAL ELECTRICITY REGULATORY COMMISSION FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 MARCH 2013

A. Income and Expenditure Account

Commission/Fees - Rs. 531.13 lakh

Since fee received for one single control period only, and the fee so received has been considered on cash basis in the year of receipt, as accrual/mercantile system of accounting is not followed over here, and introduction to that effect would require a special resolution and permission. So, spreading of the amount so received could not be done over different financial years, and no liability to this effect could be provided in the books of accounts.

Moreover, the amount of Rs. 77.20 lakh includes amount related to previous year for which, no accrued income could be shown in the previous year's balance sheet since the amount of fees is dependent on the amount of electricity trade/the installed capacity during the last financial year, which was only known to the licensee, and no objection was raised for the same also.

So, the treatment of Rs. 77.20 lakh in the balance sheet could not be provided as suggested. However, Annual Performance Review being an annual exercise, the fees so received are booked in the respective year it falls due.

B. Significant Accounting Policies/Notes to Accounts (Schedule-F)

The Commission is a statutory regulatory body devoid in any commercial activities, it is felt that no depreciation on fixed assets is to be provided for and given effect in the Annual Statement of Accounts. Moreover, the rules have not specified the methods of depreciation and rates of depreciation for different class of fixed assets to be followed for providing such depreciation.

However, the feasibility of taking into account this aspect may be considered for adoption from the next financial year.

SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES / NOTES TO ACCOUNTS

- 1. West Bengal Electricity Regulatory Commission is a Quasi Judiciary Body to perform the functions specified in clause 86 of the Electricity Act 2003. Not being a commercial organization, its receipts are not in the nature of income. The Annual Statement of Accounts, have been prepared in the formats as prescribed in the West Bengal Electricity Regulatory Commission (Annual Statement of Accounts) Rules, 2004 with certain deviations as stated in Note Nos. 2 and 3 below.
- 2. Some heads of accounts specified in the rules but not used or relevant to the Commission have been omitted from the presentation and consequently, the schedules have been re-numbered.
- 3. As mentioned in Note No. 1, the Commission is a statutory regulatory body and devoid in any commercial activity, it is felt that no depreciation on fixed assets is to be provided for and given effect in the Annual Statement of Accounts. Moreover, the rules have not specified the methods of depreciation and the rates of depreciation for different class of fixed assets to be followed for providing such depreciation. As such, no depreciation on fixed assets has been provided in the accounts.
- 4. The commission received some fixed asset items as gifts/donations. The value of those fixed assets have been capitalized and included in the capital fund. No values has, however, been assigned to some items which came as old and used without mention of cost, only the numerical accounts of those item have been maintained.
- 5. The previous year's figures have been regrouped/rearranged wherever felt necessary.
